

Introductory Membership 2019

The Introductory Membership is available as a welcome and first year introduction to the Club and entitles you to the following benefits:

- You will have full membership benefits
- You can play in and win **all** Club competitions.
- The membership can be taken up **once only** and has duration of 12 months only from the time of joining.
- At the end of the 12 month period, you can transition down to a lower category of membership or transition up to full 7 day membership.
- This will be available for **new members only**. Previous members will not be allowed to re-join at this level, but could and would be welcomed back in one of the other categories.
- The entry fee for all new members is £595.

Intermediate membership of Woodford Golf Club provides a number of benefits in **Year 1** for the equivalent of just **£49.58 a month or £5.73 a round** if you play twice a week – you can play our delightful woodland course as a 7-day member.

There is the opportunity to enter regular club competitions, to play in matches both home and away against other local golf clubs, to obtain an official handicap, to eat in our restaurant and to participate in the many and varied social activities arranged by the club.

In addition members can save appreciably on bar bills, for by using the club-issued swipe card, members get **around a 20% discount on normal beer, spirits and wine prices**.

The Main Features of 7 day Introductory Membership are:

- No entrance fee for membership.
- 7 day unrestricted membership for both men and women.
- Play in competitions or just with your friends.
- 20% Bar & Social Discount Card.
- Free County Card (18 years and over).
- Membership England Golf.
- Obtain a CONGU handicap if you don't have one.

Remember: you do not have to have a handicap to become a member. As part of becoming a member a handicap can be acquired.

Tee times are bookable by the Club Web site, Pro shop, Main office, Phone, Bar Computer or Internet for competition entry and casual play (and you are not forced to enter competitions – it is entirely up to you). As long as the tee is not closed – such as for a competition, a club match, or certain Ladies or Senior's fixtures or pre-booked – you can just turn up and play but you must report to the Pro Shop, Main office or Bar, they will book you in on request before you play.

At certain times of the day there are usually a number of members who gather for a friendly (yet often quietly competitive) round, over 9 or 18 holes.

On becoming a member, if you do not know any other members, we will arrange for you to play with at least one other member of a similar level of golf as a way of introducing you to both club and course (if you have not played it often or at all before).
