1 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

1.1 Ladies' Vice Captain Pat Collins (PC) General Manager Jonathan Gray (JG)

2. In attendance : Andy Richardson (Chair – HGC Handicap Committee)

2.1 World Handicap System: (WHS)

Andy Richardson (AR) attended an England Golf workshop in May regarding the proposed WHS to be introduced into the UK in January 2020. Two issues need to be considered by HGC and BGL prior to implementation.

1) Individual member playing handicaps to be known as 'Handicap Index' - to be calculated from a continuous averaging assessment of best 8 rounds from 20 played. A new handicap system expected to be electronically migrated using the CDH Database. No further details available yet.

2) During 2019 England Golf and Surrey Golf Union will be responsible for assessing each golf course for a 'Course Rating' and a 'Slope Rating' from the White, Yellow and Red tee areas for Hoebridge course. It was agreed that Shey Copse course should be included in the assessments to encourage new members to gain 9 hole handicaps. Prior to the ratings taking place it would be necessary to re-measure the courses which in turn would require some changes, eg to the teeing areas.

2.2. AR has discussed WHS with JG who has agreed that BGL will pay for the course measurements and slope assessments. The MC welcomed this. AR to oversee administration. **AR**

2.3 AR to talk to TEdwards and agree re fixed points (stones) on the courses. New fixed points would be required on the Shey. **AR**

2.4 AR to draft a paper on the new WHS for members and the website later in year 2.5 **R&A new rules:** AR reminded MCM of the new R&A rules to be introduced in January 2019 and considers this a priority over WHS. He would be preparing an aide memoire for members which would go in to the Club newslatter and be placed on the website.

2.6 The meeting also discussed the issue raised previously by MC of the impact that high handicaps would have on competitions. AR suggested that this issue be

considered by a separate working group on competitions_to ensure commonality and consistency across both Men and Ladies Sections. (See also 11.6). The meeting invited NS and MC to set up such a working group.

The R&A rules regarding the correct teeing position for all Stroke and Medal competitions states "The 'teeing ground' is the rectangular area two club lengths in depth, the front and the sides of which are defined by the outside limits of two tee markers." [R&A Rules Definitions page 43]. Whenever the white, yellow or red tee markers were put out they should be used. Starters' text for Club Championship competitions to be revised. **NS/MC**
