



Sunday Stableford Competitions – Advice and Procedures

The Management Committee agreed to introduce the Sunday Stableford competitions as a means for ALL members of the Club to participate and play in a qualifying competition. The procedures to sign up and enter the competitions are set out below. There will be NO tee times, the competitions will be a 'roll-up', whereby the player simply registers to play in the competition before they go out and play. This means that a player can decide to enter the competition whilst playing in their usual Sunday two-ball or four-ball – as long as one of their playing partners marked the score card.

Procedure to enter a Sunday Stableford

- Upon arrival at the Club, prior to playing, sign in and register to play via the PSI terminal.
- The £3.00 entry will be deducted from your Club Loyalty Card as you sign-in/register.
- Men will play from the yellow tees and Ladies from the red tees.
- Play will commence from either the 1st tee or the 10th tee, depending whether you are a two-ball or three- or four-ball.
- Stableford format
- CONGU Appendix 'O' will be used to calculate a CSS (Ladies will receive extra shots as per this clause.)
- Use the PSI terminals to enter scores & return score cards to the competition box outside the General Manager's office.
- Results will be processed the following morning.
- Prizes will be awarded to the top three places irrespective of handicap divisions or gender.

Should these competitions prove to be popular the Committee will consider the introduction of more in 2020.

9-hole Qualifying Competitions – Advice and Procedures

The Management Committee agreed to introduce Nine-Hole Qualifying competitions to enable those members who may not have the time to participate in 18-hole competitions to be able to maintain a competition handicap.

These nine-hole competitions will be run on Thursdays for a limited period this summer. The format will be similar to the Sunday Stablefords, in as much as there will be no tee times, play will be on a 'roll-up' basis.

The format and procedures for these competitions are listed below. The major difference is that a player's handicap will differ for a nine-hole qualifying competition. Handicap conversion sheets are available for players to calculate their handicaps depending on which nine holes the competition is being played from and which sets of tees the player will be playing from. Players should familiarise themselves with these sheets before playing and returning their scores.

Separate nine-hole score cards have been printed and will be available from the professional shop. These cards have been produced in line with England Golf's recommended SSS's for both nines and both sets of tees (Yellow and Red)

Procedure to enter a Nine-Hole Competition

- Upon arrival at the Club, prior to playing, sign in and register to play via the PSI terminal.
- The £3.00 entry will be deducted from your Club Loyalty Card as you sign-in.
- The 9 holes over which the competition will be played will be stipulated when you sign in.
- Play will be during the published start times for the size of groups i.e. two-ball or three/four-ball times. So, plan ahead and arrange to play when the start time coincides with the nine holes over which the competition is going to be played.
- Men will play from the yellow tees and Ladies from the red tees.
- Stableford format
- See handicap conversion sheets for handicap allowances.
- CONGU Appendix 'O' will be used to calculate a CSS (Ladies will receive extra shots as per this clause.)
- Use the PSI terminals to enter scores & return score cards to the competition box outside the General Manager's office.
- Results will be processed the following morning.
- Prizes will be awarded to the top three places irrespective of handicap divisions or gender.
