# RULES

## **Eligibility**

1. Drive, Chip and Putt is open to boys and girls ages 7-15. Boys and girls will compete in separate divisions in four age categories: 7-9 years old; 10-11 years old; 12-13 years old; and 14-15 years old.
2. Participants will be grouped based on their age as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019.
3. From each Club qualifier, the top two boys and girls from the four age brackets will be eligible for the Finals Day at Corhampton Golf Club.
4. The player's clubs must conform with the Rules of Golf. Balls will be provided.

## **Entry**

1. Clubs are required to complete the entry form on behalf of participants. All entry applications must be submitted by email or mail.
2. Entry applications must be received by 9am Monday 19<sup>th</sup> August 2019.
3. The cost per participant is £10.00
4. Payment may be made by Cheque to Corhampton Golf Club or by Bacs to Corhampton Golf Club, Sort Code: 16-19-28, Account Number 10029265.

## **Scoring / Competing**

- Each participant will compete in all three skills (Drive, Chip & Putt). An individual rules sheet for each skill competition is available below.
- Participants will accumulate points in each skill. The participant with the highest number of accumulated points will be declared the Overall Champion of his or her age category.
- In the case of a tie in the overall score, the putting rank will serve as the tie breaker (followed by 1) chipping and 2) driving if necessary).
- In the case of a tie in the overall score after the tie breaker, a playoff shall commence to determine the winner. This playoff shall include a single stroke at each of the skills (Drive, Chip and Putt).
- Use of a putter is not allowed for competition in the Chip Skill. Competitors may only use a lofted iron or wood club for this skill. A "chipper" club is considered an approved club for the Chip skill.
- All scoring will be based on a 25 point per shot basis, with each participant taking three shots per skill. Each participant will accumulate points per shot per skill. Each participant

will accumulate points per shot in all three skills (maximum of 75 points per skill = 25 points per shot x 3). The overall champion in each age category will be determined by the participant with the most points accumulated between all three skills (maximum of 225 points = 75 points per skill x 3).

## **DRIVING**

- 40-yard wide fairway - a shot must finish in the fairway to score points.
- Flags marking both sides of the fairway at 25-yard increments.
- A ball coming to rest on any of the boundary lines is considered in bounds.
- A ball coming to rest on any of the scoring lines will be scored in the longer of the two scoring grids.
- In the event of a tie the contestant's third drive will serve as a tie breaker (followed by second and first if necessary). If a tie still exists, co - champions of the skill will be declared.

## **CHIPPING**

- Each participant will attempt three 10-15 yard shots at the scoring hole. All shots will be measured from the centre of the hole with clearly marked scoring rings.
- A ball coming to rest on any of the scoring lines will be scored in the higher of the two point rings.
- In the event of a tie the contestant's third chip will serve as a tie breaker (followed by second and first if necessary). If a tie still exists co-champions of the skill will be declared.

### Point System for All Ages

- **1pt** A ball finishing more than 10' from the hole
- **5pts** A ball finishing 6' – 8' from the hole
- **15pts** A ball finishing 2' – 4' from the hole
- **25pts** Hole in One
- **2pts** A ball finishing 8' – 10' from the hole
- **10pts** A ball finishing 4' – 6' from the hole
- **20pts** A ball finishing 2' or nearer to the hole

### PUTTING

- Each participant will attempt one putt from each distance (6 feet, 15 feet and 30 feet). Putts will be measured from the centre of the hole with clearly marked scoring rings.
- A ball coming to rest on any of the scoring lines will be scored in the higher of the two point rings.
- In the event of a tie the contestant's third putt will serve as a tie breaker (followed by second and first if necessary). If a tie still exists co-champions of the skill will be declared.

### Point System for All Ages

- **1pt** A ball finishing more than 5' from the hole
- **5pts** A ball finishing 3' – 4' from the hole
- **15pts** A ball finishing 1' – 2' from the hole
- **25pts** Hole in One
- **2pts** A ball finishing 4' – 5' from the hole
- **10pts** A ball finishing 2' – 3' from the hole
- **20pts** A ball finishing 1' or nearer to the hole

### Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to individual skills champions as well as overall champions for boys and girls in each age category.

### Miscellaneous

1. The Finals Day will take place regardless of the weather conditions, unless it is deemed unsafe or dangerous. The decision to cancel rests with the Corhampton committee.
2. If your qualifier is cancelled or not held for any reason you may still enter two boys and girls from the four age brackets.
3. The Corhampton committee reserve the right to make any amendments to the skills competition as required and all decisions are final.
