

Rules of the Rabbit's Competitions as laid down by the Rabbit's Committee.

These are also shown on the Club Competition Rules Section of the Website and in the Men's Locker Room.

Rabbits Knockout Competition

This is a singles drawn Matchplay knockout competition played off FULL Handicap difference, played on the Yellow Course and runs from April to September. The draw for the Preliminary Round takes place as soon after the 30th April as possible and the names will be posted on the notice board. Competitors will arrange their own matches as is convenient for both players. If the match cannot be completed in the required time scale, both players will be disqualified. Any disputes should be referred to the Rabbit Captain, whose decision is final.

Buck Rabbit Competition

This is a Medal competition and is taken from 3 specific Medal Competitions

1. A monthly medal held in late May
2. Vice Captain's Prize Day
3. Rabbit Captain Prize Day

Points are awarded for places in the above competitions and the top 12 points scorers qualify for the Buck Rabbit Final which is held in September, (see club diary for date as this varies year on year). Once the 12 finalists are known details of the draw will be published on the Rabbit's Section of the Club Website and the Rabbit's Notice Board.

This competition is organised by the Competitions Coordinator.

Golden Rabbit Competition

This is a Medal competition and is awarded to the golfer who has scored the best total placing's in the designated monthly Medal competitions held between April and October. This competition is organised by the Competitions Coordinator and regular updates will be posted on the Rabbit's Section of the Club Website and Notice Board.

Rabbits "Chinchilla" Competition

This is a Stableford competition and is awarded to the golfer who has scored the best total placing's in the designated monthly Stableford competitions held between April and October. This competition is organised by the Competitions Coordinator and regular updates will be posted on the Rabbit's Section of the Club Website and notice board.
