

MEN CALCUTTA CUP PAIRS

Background

Presented by George Renwick on 14th November 1969 in his Captain's year.

Format History

Instituted as a pairs matchplay competition.

Current

18 holes matchplay, 90% handicap difference allowance.

All matches to start at the 1st hole. In the event of a tie after 18 holes, the match becomes sudden death starting at the first with strokes given as in the first 18 holes.

All entrants must have active handicaps. 6 day members are eligible to enter.

Specified deadlines for completing each round, and registering the result on the draw sheet, must be strictly observed. If not both pairs will be eliminated.

Both pairs are responsible for arranging the match.

The prizes pot will be the entry fees less the usual deductions.

The winners will receive 50 %, runners-up 30 % and the losing semi-finalists 10% each pair.

Restrictions

Junior members may play if they have an official handicap of 12 or less on the date of the draw.
