



DRESS CODE - CLUBHOUSE

- At all times, except when an event specifies a different dress code i.e. Black Tie or Jacket and Tie, Members are required to wear an acceptable and reasonable form of casual dress in all areas of the Clubhouse.
- The wearing of smart denim jeans are permitted in the Clubhouse unless otherwise specified, Sunday Carveries and Private Functions are “Relaxed Dress Code”.
- Appropriate footwear must be work at all times. Golf shoes are only allowed in spike bar when open.
- T-Shirts, rugby, football, cricket or any shirt with prominent logos or numbers are not allowed on the Clubhouse.
- Golf shorts are permitted in the Clubhouse during the summer course season.
- Any mobile telephone calls are to be made or taken outside the main Clubhouse rooms.

DRESS CODE – COURSE

- Recognised Golf attire to be worn at all times
- Golf Shoes must be work on the course
- No denim whatsoever
- No T Shirts, rugby, football, cricket or any shirt with prominent logos or members are allowed on the course
- No combat or camouflage “type” trousers or shorts to be worn on the course
- Ladies golf shirts that have been designed/tailored to wear outside trousers/shorts/skirts may be worn. All other shirts should be tucked in to trousers/shorts/skirts.
