

I first heard about the Appeal when I was invited to 'a golf day' by Kevin Kelly, the owner of Axis Polythene, one of my suppliers when I was in business. I arrived thinking it was just another company golf day. What a surprise when I walked into the clubhouse and saw all the prizes and donations for the auction to be held later that day!

After a great days golf and a lovely meal, Kevin said that prior to the prize giving there would be a presentation of wheel-chairs. We all gathered on the putting green for the presentation of 6 wheelchairs, a humbling experience, rounded off by Bert Dyson saying that one of the recipients wanted to say something. Now, this young man sitting in his chair, with his head on his headrest and his hand round the golf ball controller said: "You don't know what this means to us and I would like to thank you all" Every time I mention this, the hairs on my neck start to stand up!! He was right, we don't and from that moment I have attended every event except one and as long as Helsby Golf Club will let me attend, I will try and get there every June!!

I live in a small village in Norfolk, Swanton Morley which is 241 miles from Helsby, a round trip of 482 miles and, in all this time, I have never won the longest drive! Kathryn Hoather asked me 'How many miles do you think you have driven to attend the Classic every year?' My best guesstimate is 9,700 miles which will increase to over 10,000 miles this year!!

How does it make me feel to be a supporter? Wednesday 3rd August 2016 - MEGA Day


