



SOCIETY INFORMATION

It is our intention that you have an enjoyable and memorable day here at Cleethorpes Golf Club. We assume that your society is familiar with the general rules and etiquette of the game and so do not want to overburden you with unnecessary information. Instead, for your guidance, here are just some key points to remember.

Dress Code:

Our dress code is largely a matter of common sense and is in line with most clubs in the request for recognised golfing attire on the course, including appropriate footwear. A copy of our dress rules is enclosed. Please can you make sure that all your members are aware of these requirements.

Playing Ability:

We expect all golfers to be of a reasonable standard and conversant with the rules of the game. The club reserves the right to ask any player to leave the course who appears to be lacking ability or knowledge of the rules and etiquette.

Tees:

Preferred tee times can be requested on your booking form and we will do our best to meet these times.

Buggies and Pro Shop:

Please visit our pro shop which you will find well stocked and competitively priced. We have 2 buggies and manual trolleys available for hire. It is advisable to book buggies prior to your visit. Please check our full buggy/trolley policy which can be found on our website under 'About' and the sub heading 'Buggy'. An important aspect to note relates to restrictions for individuals with medical exemptions to use ride on buggies and trolleys safely at times when the golf course is deemed unsuitable for buggy and trolley use by able bodied people – up to date medical certificates will be required. Mobile Phones:

We do not prohibit the use of mobile telephones in the clubhouse with the exception of the dining room. However, we ask that you are courteous to people around you when using them. Mobile telephones are allowed on the golf course but are only to be used in the case of an emergency.

Payment of Account:

All accounts must be settled on the day in the Pro Shop, unless otherwise agreed with the Secretary's Office. The names of all your golfers who are in attendance are required on a form provided on the day by our professionals.

Clubhouse Opening Hours:

The clubhouse opens at 10am. Should you require food before this time please ensure you book this in advance. N.B. Tea and coffee is always available in the spike bar.
