Donncha started the back nine with a brace of pars and then had a nice birdie four on the 12th - probably a drive and an iron to the green for this big hitter and with plenty of run on the ball the green was well within his reach in two. Two more pars were followed by another birdie this one on the 15th. Yet again two more pars were followed by a great birdie on the 18th which gave him an incredible back nine of 3 under par for 26 points and a total of 43. In second place was Jonathan O'Mahoney who had a very good front nine of 22 points and indeed he may have gone home thinking he had a winning 44 points but unfortunately, he erred with his points earned on the 14th but he has to be very satisfied with his progress to date. Continuing with consistent form was Sam Morrissey, off of 7 handicap, who had a very good 41 points and was in third place. The gross was won by Liam Phelan off of 3 handicap with a score of 34 points.
