Code of Conduct for Junior Members of Waterford Golf Club

Junior Members and their Parents/Guardians are required to read the Code of Conduct, sign the Declaration, and return it to the club office, for the attention of the Junior Committee. The Rules shall be observed always within the grounds and environs of Waterford Golf Club, also when representing and competing at other clubs.

Code of Conduct

- 1. The club's rules and established practices shall be fully observed.
- 2. The game of golf should always be played in a sporting manner. The rules of the game shall be adhered to always.
- 3. Players must be correctly attired for golf smart casual,
- 4. Juniors should treat leaders, organisers, club officers and coaches with fairness and respect. Accept their advice with grace.
- 5. Treat others as you would like to be treated yourself, that includes opponents as well as players.
- 6. Bullying, unruly or disruptive behavior and abusive language will not be tolerated.
- 7. The club facilities, this includes the course, practice ground should not be damaged intentionally.
- 8. Drug or substance abuse of any kind is not allowed, including under- age smoking or alcohol consumption.
- 9. The Junior Committee should be made aware of any underlying medical condition a junior member may have. Such information will be treated confidentially
- 11. Juniors while in the Club House must adhere to the following rules:
 - (i) Junior members are not allowed to sit at the bar
 - (ii) Junior members are not allowed to run up and down the Stairs
 - (iii) Shouting or the use of abusive language will not be tolerated.
- (iv) In accordance with our Child Protection Policy, boys are not allowed to enter the Ladies locker room and girls are not allowed to enter the men's locker room. Locker rooms are not to be used as waiting areas.
- 12. Junior Boys and Girls must have their names entered for all competitions. Juniors <u>Must</u> report to the Junior Volunteer on duty before play.
- 13. The Junior Committee looks after all the Junior competitions and they also supervise all juniors on the course
- 14. When Juniors are not playing in competitions they must always phone the pro shop to book a time to play casual golf before coming to the club to avoid disappointment.
- 15 All Juniors must receive permission from the pro shop to go to the practice area.
- 16. Parents and Guardian please let the leader of the day know when Juniors are being collected after competitions
- 17. Any Parent / Guardian / Junior refusing to sign Code of Conduct cannot be a Member of the Junior Club at Waterford Golf.
