



Policy for Open Competitions

This matter was discussed at The Golf Committee Meeting on Thursday 29th May 2014 where it was agreed the club needed a protocol to deal with Open Competitions that are affected by weather or other events.

- 1) The Organiser agrees in advance with the Club Captain and Golf Committee an appropriate date in the event a competition is abandoned.
- 2) In the event that either more than 50% of the competitors have completed their rounds or the field of competitors have all completed 10 holes of the Golf Course when the competition is abandoned, the Competition is regarded the same as if it had been fully completed, and the result stands. Each Visitor who has not been able to complete their round will be presented with a voucher for a complimentary round of Golf.
- 3) In the event that less than 50% of the field have completed their rounds or that the field have completed less than 10 holes of the Golf Course, the competition will be deemed abandoned to the pre-arranged date and played again from scratch. All Competitors are expected to return on the revised Competition date. Any visitors that cannot will be offered a voucher for a complimentary round of Golf.
- 4) In the event that the re-arranged Competition is abandoned and point 2 cannot be applied the Competition will be declared void and the assets (prizes etc) are held and carried forward. Visitors will be offered a voucher for a complimentary round of golf.
- 5) Vouchers are issued to a named person and valid for 12 months from date of issue.
