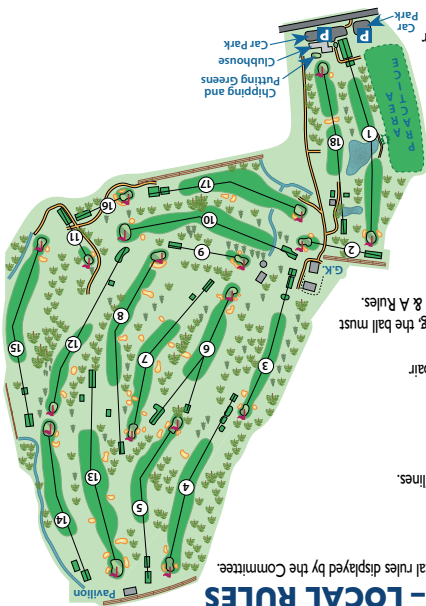

PETERBOROUGH MILTON GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

The following local rules shall apply in addition to the full and any supplementary / temporary local rules displayed by the Committee.

OUT OF BOUNDS

Beyond any fence, wall, hedge or line of white stakes marking the boundary of the course.

WATER HAZARDS

All water hazards are marked by yellow stakes/lines and all lateral water hazards by red stakes/lines.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

All areas appropriately marked by the green-keeper.

All newly tined or seeded areas are ground under repair from which play is prohibited.

Deep tractor or vehicle ruts but not shallow indentations.

Severe animal damage caused by such as squirrels or birds may be treated as ground under repair.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

All staked trees: If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing the ball must be lifted without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure in accordance with R & A Rules.

If a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play

between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief. Artificially surfaced roads and paths

MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions in accordance with R & A Rules.

BALL ON PUTTING GREEN ACCIDENTALLY MOVED

When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced in accordance with R & A Rules.

OVERHEAD POWERLINES

If a ball strikes the power line during play of the 2nd hole, the stroke is cancelled and the player must play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance with R & A Rules.
