

Dear Member

As some of you may know, we have a 100 Club at Rushden GC to raise money for the club. However, some newer members may not be aware of this so I feel it is a good time to remind you of it again now.

How does this work?

There will be a draw each month and 3 numbers will be drawn out. The 3 winning numbers will win cash prizes.

How much prize money will be given out?

50% of the money taken will be given out in prizes and 50% will go to the Club. So, for example, if 100 people play in a month that is £1,000. £500 will go into prizes (split as 1st - £300, 2nd - £150, 3rd - £50) and £500 to the Club.

However, the more people who enter then the bigger the prize fund will be. A list of winners is on the noticeboard in the entrance hallway so you can see how much people have won.

How much does it cost?

Each number costs £10 per month. Most people who enter will have 1 number but you can have more if you wish. When you join the 100 Club you will need to commit for 12 months after which time you can drop out if you wish.

Do I keep the same number each month or change it?

Yes, you keep the same number(s) each month.

Which Categories of membership is the 100 Club open to?

The 100 Club is open to all categories of membership.

What do I need to do to take part in the 100 Club?

If you wish to take part in the 100 Club, please write your name against the number(s) you want on the list which is now in the entrance hallway.

See Andy in the office to complete a standing order mandate. The money will be taken monthly from your bank on or around the 24th of each month. If for any reason your payment is not received by our bank on the last day of the month you will not be entered into the draw.

What if I want to take part and all 100 numbers are taken?

The initial list will have 100 numbers and people can put their name against the number(s) they want. If this fills up then we will add another list with numbers from 101 to 200. Therefore everyone will have a chance to enter if they wish.

When does the draw take place?

The draw takes place on the 2nd Saturday of each month.

Do I need to be present at the draw to win if my number is drawn out?

No, you don't need to be at the club when the draw takes place as winners will be notified.
