

Dress Code



Yelverton Golf Club aims to operate a contemporary and forward-thinking dress policy, commensurate with a modern-day golf club. It is within our interest to maintain reasonable standards of casual/smart dress in keeping with golfing traditions. Golfers are therefore reminded of the following required standards which must be adhered to, both on the golf course and in the clubhouse.



All mobile phones must be switched to silent in all areas of the club and all calls conducted outside of the clubhouse



Clothing

When on the Golf Course

Trousers and shorts (for all) and/or skirts (for women). However, denim jeans, tracksuits, sports shorts, cargo shorts or cut downs are not permitted.

Golf shirts must have collars (turtle necks and other branded shirts are also acceptable). Football, rugby or shirts with indiscreet slogans or logos are not permitted and shirts should be worn inside trousers.

Golf shoes (soft spike preferred) must be worn. Any other footwear which is not a recognised golf shoe is not permitted.

Caps must be worn in conventional mode.

When in the Clubhouse

A good standard of smart, casual dress must be worn.

*Modern, casual shoes are permitted including smart trainers, sandals, loafers and deck shoes. Socks are not required with these options. **Flip Flops are not permitted in the clubhouse.***

Smart shirts designed to be worn outside trousers, shorts, or skirts are permitted.

Golf shoes, caps and waterproofs are only acceptable in the locker rooms.

All clothing, including denim, must be clean, not faded, torn or soiled.
