## MEN CAMPBELL CUP

### Background

Presented on 6 August 1912 by Athol A Campbell (who it seems had a reputation for being somewhat awkward) for handicaps 12 and over.

### Format History

Originally four qualifying rounds of stroke play, each producing two qualifiers who then played matchplay quarter-final, semi-final and final.

In 1912 (3 September) changed to knockout.

In 1913 format changed to two qualifying medal rounds each producing four qualifiers who then played matchplay knockout, as Thompson Cup.

In 1916 format changed to two qualifying medal rounds.

### Current

**Handicaps 13 and over.**

**Best aggregate over two rounds of strokeplay.**

**Full allowance. Handicap limit 28.**

**No handicap adjustment between rounds.**

**Played with the Second Division Championship and Orman Shield,  
10% of prize pot on each round held in reserve for eventual winner.**

**White tees when available.**

### Restrictions

**Junior members may play if they have an official handicap of 21 or less,  
and they play with a member of 18 years of age or over.**

**Junior members may not win the competition.**
