1. **Booking Confirmation:**

Your golf day will be confirmed in writing on receipt of a completed booking form which must be accompanied by a deposit of £75 and returned within 10 days of the original provisional booking being made. After this time your booking may be released without notice. Unfortunately, deposits are non-refundable.
2. **Dress Codes:**

A good standard of dress, both off and on the golf course, is expected from all Club users and the following dress codes will apply on your golf day:-

The Clubhouse: Smart-casual attire will be expected of all guests, all T-shirts must have a collar. Tracksuits, waterproofs and hats are not acceptable attire.

The Course: If shorts are worn, knee-high socks of any colour or predominately white sports socks are acceptable. All shirts must have a collar and be tucked into trousers. Trousers must not be tucked into socks. Jeans, T-Shirts and tracksuits are not accepted as suitable attire.
Mobile Phones may only be used in the Car Park.
3. **Costs:**

A number of packages are available and can be tailored to suit all pockets and a tariff of prices are enclosed to help you plan your golf day. This list is not exhaustive and if you require alternatives, please phone the Club Secretary on 01384 395566 to discuss your requirements.
4. **Catering:**

It would be appreciated if provisional numbers and menu could be sent at least two weeks prior to the date of booking. Final numbers must then be with the Office at least 48 hours in advance of your golf day. Please ensure your final numbers are correct as the Club operates a rigid 48 hour rule which means societies will be billed for final numbers for catering. Societies who do not confirm final numbers more than 48 hours in advance will be held to their provisional numbers, which will be subject to a minimum booking of 12 golfers.
5. **Special Dietary Requirements:**

Special dietary requirements can be catered for, but please try and give a little more notice of their requirements to assist the Caterer.
6. **Golf Course Courtesies:**

No reduction in fees can be made for PGA, GCMA, BIGGA or County Card Members when playing with a visiting society.
7. **Payment of Account:**

All invoices must be settled in full "prior to play". It would be appreciated if the organiser could please pay the invoice by a single payment either by cheque, cash, or Debit/Credit Card.
8. **Behaviour of Societies:**

It is the Society Organisers responsibility to ensure the good behaviour of their society, that they are acquainted with the Club's dress code and are sufficiently accomplished to play the golf course.
9. **Guest Property:**

Stourbridge Golf Club cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage to guest's property, however caused.
