A & I DOBSON

<u>Format:</u> Scratch matchplay knockout for top 8 players in the SCRATCH TROPHY. Handicap scratch.

ALAN WILSON CUPS men and ladies

Presented by Mr. Alan Wilson who was a member of the Club and was the proprietor of Messrs Wilson and Hirst antique shop in Grange next to the Post Office.

<u>Format:</u> WHITE TEES FOR MEN, RED TEES FOR LADIES. Mixed INDIVIDUAL competition played every Wednesday in June. STROKEPLAY handicap max 24 for men, 30 plus 3 for ladies. The Alan Wilson cup is awarded for the best aggregate nett score over any two rounds with a smaller cup awarded for the best nett of the opposite sex. Only one entry fee for all rounds.

ALL IRONS

Format: 9 Hole STABLEFORD. Full Handicap.

BIRDIE PRIZE

All competitions throughout Summer. Continuous from the first game on a full course until end of season.

BIRLEY CUP men and ladies

Presented in 1939 to the old Grange Club by the family of Mr. Birley who lived in what is now the Methven Hotel. It was brought with other cups during the war and played for from 1948.

<u>Format:</u> WHITE TEES FOR MEN, RED TEES FOR LADIES. Mixed INDIVIDUAL competition. STROKEPLAY handicap max 18 for men, 30 plus 3 for ladies. The BIRLEY CUP is awarded for the best nett score with a prize awarded for the best nett of the opposite sex.

BOYD TROPHY

Donated by Mr. JOHN BOYD.

Format: 18 Hole STROKEPLAY. Handicap maximum 30.

CATERERS' CUP

This competition is open to all members including juniors with handicaps. <u>Format:</u> TEXAS SCRAMBLE, shotgun start, teams drawn from the entry sheet. Handicap: total of high, low and average of other two per team.

CHALLENGE CUP

Presented to the Club in 1931.

<u>Format:</u> SINGLES MATCHPLAY KNOCKOUT. Handicap maximum 30. Allowance full handicap difference.

CHRISTMAS BIRD

If competition cancelled, draw for 1st and 2nd.

Format: 18 or 9 hole STABLEFORD. Full handicap.

CHRISTMAS CRACKER

Format: 9 hole STABLEFORD. Full handicap.

CORONATION FOURSOMES

LLCGA (Lancashire Ladies County Golf Association) FOURSOMES qualifying competition. Winning couple go forward to regional finals. THIS COMPETITION HAS NOT BEEN ENTERED SINCE 2012.

<u>Format:</u> FOURSOMES played off ½ combined handicap.

DAILY MAIL FOURSOMES

This is a National competition. Winners go through to the Regional knockout, which is MATCHPLAY.

<u>Format:</u> 18 hole FOURSOMES. Format can be decided by the Club. Handicap maximum 30, play off half the combined handicap.

EDNA MARTLAND TROPHY

The Autumn meeting for the EDNA MARTLAND TROPHY was started in 2003. The trophy is a Lladro figure of a Lady Golfer purchased with monies from the generous legacy received by the Ladies Section from Miss Martland. Format: 18 hole STROKEPLAY. Handicap maximum 30. In the afternoon 9 hole foursomes. ½ combined handicap.

FELLGATE CUP

This is one of the trophies brought from the original 9 hole Golf Club at MIDDLE FELL GATE. The cup is contested by the L.G.U. Medal winners from throughout the year in each division.

<u>Format:</u> 18 hole STROKEPLAY. Full handicap. An 18 hole STABLEFORD is arranged for those not playing in the FELLGATE. Full handicap.

<u>FLAG</u>

<u>Format:</u> 18 or 9 hole STROKEPLAY. Course par plus full handicap or ½ course par plus ½ handicap gives number of strokes allowed. Mark on card where you finished, or, if greater, place flag where last shot landed.

4BBB (Fourball better ball)

Format: FOURBALL BETTER BALL, 18 or 9 holes. Full handicap.

FOURSOMES

Format: FOURSOMES. Play off half the combined handicap.

FOURSOMES KNOCKOUT

Two small pierced bon-bon dishes bought with donations by Lady Members in 1994.

<u>Format:</u> DOUBLES FOURSOMES KNOCKOUT. Handicap maximum 30, ½ combined handicaps, allowance full handicap difference.

FRANCES SMITH

<u>Format:</u> 18 hole STROKEPLAY MEDAL. Full handicap. Player with the best nett score shall be deemed to be the Club's representative in the L.L.C.G.A. (Lancashire Ladies County Golf Association) final.

<u>GREENSOMES</u>

<u>Format:</u> GREENSOMES. Handicap taken from table (one in green file).

HILDA LEGGATT FOURSOMES also known as SCOTT LEGATT

This is an L.L.C.G.A. (Lancashire Ladies County Golf Association) qualifying competition. One couple per every 20 members will go forward to the divisional finals.

<u>Format:</u> 18 hole FOURSOMES STABLEFORD. Handicap limit – any combination of current handicap, half of which does not exceed 30.

INVITATION DAY

Format: FOURBALL BETTER BALL STABLEFORD. ¾ Handicap.

LADY CAPTAIN'S CHARITY

Format: 18 hole. At the discretion of the Lady Captain. Individual or team. Full handicap.

LADY CAPTAIN'S DAY

Format: 18 hole. Format at the discretion of the Lady Captain. Handicap decided by the Lady Captain. Shotgun start possible.

LADY CAPTAIN'S DRIVE-IN

Format: 18 holes. Format at the discretion of the Lady Captain. Full handicap.

LADY VICE CAPTAIN'S PRIZE

<u>Format:</u> At the discretion of the Lady Vice Captain. Full handicap. Can be team format.

MARGARET CARRUTHERS ROSE BOWL

Presented by Miss Carruthers's family. Miss Carruthers died on the golf course whilst playing in the Spring Meeting of 1986 so this trophy is presented to the winner on the Spring Meeting day.

<u>Format:</u> 18 hole STROKEPLAY. Handicap maximum 30. In the afternoon 9 hole FOURSOMES STROKEPLAY. Full handicap, ¼ total handicaps to 2 decimal places.

MASCORD TROPHY men and ladies

Presented by Mrs. M. Mascord in 1971 in memory of Mr. Reg. Mascord. The trophy was originally a number of old clubs but in 1995 it was decided to present a cup as the trophy.

<u>Format:</u> WHITE TEES FOR MEN, RED TEES FOR LADIES. Mixed INDIVIDUAL competition. STROKEPLAY handicap max 18 for men, 30 plus 3 for ladies. The MASCORD TROPHY is awarded for the best nett score with a prize awarded for the best nett of the opposite sex.

MEDALS

Format: STROKEPLAY. Full handicap.

MILLENIUM TROPHY

Donated by the Lady Past Captains.

Format: 18 hole STROKEPLAY. Handicap maximum 30.

NELL BRIGG FOURSOMES

Two small clocks were donated in 1973 by Miss Edna Martland in memory of her dear friend Nell Brigg.

<u>Format:</u> 18 hole FOURSOMES STROKEPLAY. Handicap maximum 30. ½ the combined handicap.

NIKKI CORNISH TROPHY

Awarded to the most improved player.

OLYMPIC FLAME

Format: FOURSOMES. Handicap max. 30. Play off half the combined handicap.

PAR TREE

All competitions throughout Summer. Continuous from the first game on a full course until end of season. Only applicable to Full Members with a handicap of 21+ on the day of the Spring Meeting.

PAST LADY CAPTAINS

Format: At the discretion of the immediate Past Captain. 7/8 handicap.

PRESIDENT'S DAY

Format: At the discretion of the President. Handicap decided by the President.

PRO'S WINTER SERIES men and ladies

Played during the winter between November and March.

<u>Format:</u> VARIOUS. YELLOW TEES and handicap limit 28 for men, handicap limit 36 for ladies and own card. Winners qualify for 4BBB final.

QUAICH TROPHY

Presented by Mrs. C. Comboy, then the President, on behalf of the L.G.U. on the occasion of the Club Centenary in 1993.

Format: 18 hole STROKEPLAY. Handicap maximum 30.

QUEEN MOTHER'S CUP

Entry monies go to the Marie Curie charity. THIS CUP HAS NOT BEEN COMPETED FOR FOR SOME YEARS. The fixture was replaced by LADY CAPTAIN'S CHARITY.

Format: STABLEFORD

SAMPOOL TROPHY

Donated by Mrs. Ivy Dobson for BRONZE DIVISION players. <u>Format:</u> STROKEPLAY. Handicap 21 to 36. Best nett of 36 holes played over two consecutive days. Prize also for best gross.

SCRATCH TROPHY

Grange new Golf Club Captain's prize presented in 1935 by C.J.C. Small. The winner of this trophy is considered the Ladies' Champion for that year. <u>Format:</u> 36 hole STROKEPLAY. Best GROSS. Silver division 0 – 20. SCRATCH. Prize also for best nett.

SILVER v BRONZE MATCH

Format: SINGLES MATCHPLAY. 7 players from each division. Full handicap.

SPRING CHICKENS

Competition for Ladies aged up to 60. Played on the same day as the Veterans' Cup.

Format: STABLEFORD. Handicap maximum 30.

SUMMER ECLECTIC

Best score on each hole over the season with a percentage of the handicap taken off. Done by the computer.

Qualifying competitions only count, i.e. qualifying for handicap adjustment. Continuous from the first qualifying competition on a full course until end of season.

TEXAS SCRAMBLE

<u>Format:</u> Team of 3. 18 or 9 hole (can be a draw). All players tee off, select drive, must use 5 or 2 drives of each player. Chosen drive is marked and goes first. Other players place their ball within 6 inches (15 cms) of mark on fairway or drop in rough. Repeat until hole out. Total of handicaps divided by 6.

THOMPSON BOWL

Donated by Col. Thompson.

<u>Format:</u> SINGLES MATCHPLAY KNOCKOUT. Final over 36 holes. Handicap maximum 30. Allowance full handicap difference.

3 x 6 HANDICAP DRAW

<u>Format:</u> 18 hole TEAM OF 3 STABLEFORD. Full handicap.

- 1 Score to count on holes 1 6
- 2 Scores to count on holes 7 12
- 3 Scores to count on holes 13 to 18

3 CLUBS AND PUTTER

<u>Format:</u> 9 hole STABLEFORD. Full handicap.

VETERANS' TROPHY

Originally started by the older Lady Members aged 60 and over, a cup was presented by way of a joke. The competition proved to be so popular that the cup was then set on a base and a plate added for winners' names. Edna Clegg provided the cup to be presented at the annual prize giving. Format: 18 hole STABLEFORD. Handicap maximum 30.

WALTZ

<u>Format:</u> 18 or 9 hole STABLEFORD. Full handicap. Team of 3. Record best score on 1st, best 2 on 2nd, all three on 3rd. Repeat throughout round.

WINTER ECLECTIC

All Winter competitions count. Run throughout Winter over 1st 9 holes. Best score on each hole over the season with a percentage of handicap taken off.

WINTER LEAGUE

Played monthly.

Format: 18 hole STABLEFORD. Full handicap.

YELLOW BALL

<u>Format:</u> Team of 3. 18 or 9 hole STABLEFORD. Players take it in turn to be YELLOW BALL i.e. 1/4/7 etc. Score yellow ball + one other on each hole. Full handicap.
