



ON THE GOLF COURSE:

GOLF SHIRTS: Shirts must be of a proper golfing style with sleeves and a collar, and must always be tucked into the waistband of trousers. Ladies may wear golf tops outside trousers/shorts/skirts if the tops have been designed to do so.

SHORTS: These must be tailored and must not be below the knee. When playing in shorts men must wear socks, and these must be predominately white.

HEADWEAR: All caps and headwear must be worn with the peaks to the front at all times.

FOOTWEAR: Recognised golf shoes with spikes or dimples must be worn.

IN THE CLUBHOUSE:

In addition to the above, the following list of clothing items and styles are PROHIBITED ANYWHERE in the Clubhouse:

- Blue denim jeans, trousers/shorts/skirts/shirts
- T-shirts or team sport shirts (eg: rugby/football tops bearing numbers or logos)
- Bermuda-style shorts/cargo shorts or trousers/leisure shorts (with draw string)
- Hats of any description
- Trousers tucked into socks
- Training shoes.

Golf shoes of any kind are prohibited in the lounge.

In the Clubhouse socks are not compulsory if, for example, deck shoes or loafers are worn. Flip-flops and sandals, however, are not permitted. Waterproof tops, golf jackets and wet or muddy golf wear are not to be worn in the Clubhouse.

Following a round of golf, and prior to using the bars and lounge, members and visitors are encouraged to shower and change, in keeping with good hygiene standards.
