

ALL BUNKERS OUT OF PLAY

If a player's ball (i) comes to rest in a Bunker, (ii) on a slope/decline leading down to a Bunker or (iii) the player's stance must be taken on such slopes/declines in order to play the ball, the player **MUST** proceed as per the following 2 options:

(a) Drop a ball, **without penalty**, behind the point where the ball lay, keeping that point (see Picture below) directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is to be Dropped, with no limit to how far behind that point, the ball may be Dropped.

(b) Under Stroke & Distance, Rule 18.1, for a **penalty of one stroke**, play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played.
