- Risk to users of the public footpath running along the 10th and 11th holes and golfers on the 11th tee discussed. It had recently been reported that a lady was struck by a ball from the 10th tee. It was agreed that a sign be placed on the 10th tee reminding golfer of the footpath. It was agreed that the trees to the left beyond the 11th tee should remain as although they obscured sight of walkers, they provided protection from stray golf balls.

A fence at the back of the 11^{th} tee was considered, but it was felt that as golfers on this tee and the 10^{th} fairway were visible to each other it was not needed.

Ladies - Repeater post for Ladies 18th tee will be in place shortly. Hedge behind the 2nd green is encroaching onto the footpath. Signage on Chapel Car Park needs to be bigger so as to stop non golf club usage.
