

Full Membership - 2018

Full membership of Woodford Golf Club provides a number of benefits for the equivalent of just £62.50p a month or £7.21p a round if you play twice a week – you can play our delightful woodland course as a 7-day member.

There is the opportunity to enter regular club competitions, to play in matches both home and away against other local golf clubs, to obtain an official handicap, to eat in our restaurant and to participate in the many and varied social activities arranged by the club.

In addition members can save appreciably on bar bills, for by using the club-issued swipe card, members get **around a 25% discount on normal beer, spirits and wine prices.**

The Main Features of 7 day Full Membership are:

- No entrance fee for membership.
- 7 day unrestricted membership for both men and women.
- Play in all competitions or just with your friends.
- 25% Bar & Social Discount Card.
- Free County Card (18 years and over).
- Membership England Golf.
- Obtain a CONGU handicap if you don't have one.
- Subscriptions may be paid monthly by arrangement.
- Reduced Subscription rates for family membership.
- Reduced rates under 30, 26, 22, 18, 14 years old.
- Under 14 children can play accompanied by their parent, guardian or grandparent without a green fee payment. (Subject to tee time availability)
- Reduced venue hire charges for members.

7-day membership.....£750

Adult full membership subscriptions may be paid by 10 monthly instalments of £77.50p by arrangement with the Main Office.

Junior membership costs £75 a year for Under-14s, £120 for Under-18s, £250 for Under-22s, £350 for Under-26s, and £450 for Under-30s.

Country class membership (resident 50 miles or more from the club) is £80 annually.

Remember: you do not have to have a handicap to become a member. As part of becoming a member a handicap can be acquired.

Tee times are bookable by the Club Web site, Pro shop, Main office, Phone, Bar Computer or Internet for competition entry and casual play (and you are not forced to enter competitions – it is entirely up to you). As long as the tee is not closed – such as for a competition, a club match, or certain Ladies or Senior's fixtures or pre-booked – you can just turn up and play but you must report to the Pro Shop, Main office or Bar, they will book you in on request before you play. The only exception is for a 7 day member to facilitate practice in a practice area or play singularly on the course where the player will have no standing on the course and must stand aside and let other players play through.

At certain times of the day there are usually a number of members who gather for a friendly (yet often quietly competitive) round, over 9 or 18 holes.

On becoming a member, if you do not know any other members, we will arrange for you to play with at least one other member of a similar level of golf as a way of introducing you to both club and course (if you have not played it often or at all before).
