FEEDBACK FROM MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING DECEMBER 18th, 2018

1. Sat 12th January - 2.00pm, A Richardson will run a seminar on the new rules for 2019.
2. PSI board – a meeting was held with a representative from CSI to demonstrate the proposed PSI board. The initial cost is approximately £1250 with annual costs of about £250. J Gray stated that BGL would cover the lion's share of the hardware and the annual running costs. He rejected the suggestion of selling advertising space to outside companies.
