Information for the Guidance of Visitors

General

- 1.0 The Clubhouse is open from 07.30 hours when coffee and breakfast, if ordered beforehand, will be available from the Restaurant.**
- 1.1 Ride-On buggies are only permitted for use by authorised disabled users. Please contact the office for further details.**
- 1.2 Payments in respect of Green Fees, Bar and Catering Bills must be made to the Secretary or Hospitality Manager prior to departure.**
- 1.3 Cancellations within 14 days but more than 48 hours prior to Society Day will necessitate payment based on half the number of players submitted on the original application.**
- 1.4 Cancellations less than 48 hours prior to the Society Day will necessitate payment in full.**
- 1.5 There may be limitations as to the use of the Main Lounge. These will be controlled by the Secretary or Bar Manager.**
- 1.6 Should entertainment be required for your day, sanction must be obtained from the Secretary at the time of booking.**
- 1.7 The use of mobile telephones is not permitted in the Clubhouse.**

Handicaps

- 2.0 All players in your Society must hold a Club or Society handicap. On no account will non golfers be permitted to play. In the case of non-compliance with this requirement no future bookings will be accepted.**

General Play

- 3.0 All divots should be replaced, foot marks in bunkers raked, pitchmarks on the greens repaired and normal rules of etiquette observed.**
- 3.1 Play will be from the yellow tees.**
- 3.2 Trolleys must not be taken over the green surrounds and on tees.**

Practice

- 4.0 Practising is only permitted on the practice ground, the chipping area and the putting green. Practice chipping on to or from the putting green is not allowed.**

Dress and Club House Regulations

(Revised November 2017)

The Board would advise that each member is responsible for their own and their guests attire and request members always dress appropriately.

Our "Smart Casual" policy applies at all times unless advertised otherwise. Variations are shown in brackets.

In the clubhouse:

- **Allowed:**
 - clean dry golfwear
 - collared shirts
 - tailored shorts, skirts, skorts all of respectable length
 - smart sandals with or without socks

- **Not allowed:**
 - muddy or dirty footwear
 - wet or muddy clothing
 - golfing waterproofs
 - track suits
 - blue denim jeans
 - combat shorts with multiple pockets
 - vests or racer back shirts
 - tee-shirts (Ladies may wear collarless and sleeveless items)
 - beach wear type flip-flops and clothing
 - bare or stockinged feet
 - golf shoes
 - trainers
 - caps/hats

- The Club will not be responsible for the security of any valuables left unattended.
- Prams and pushchairs are not permitted in the lounge or dining room unless approved by the Club House Manager of the day.
- Children under the age of 16 years will not be permitted to remain at the club after 8pm or once any scheduled entertainment commences unless the Social Committee have agreed otherwise.
- Mobile phones must not be used for calls in the lounge, dining room, Robertson bar, or on the course during play (apart from ordering food at the 9th tee), unless there is an emergency.
- Coats and Jackets must be hung in the appropriate area and not on the back of chairs.

On the course:

- **Allowed:**
 - collared polo shirts, golf clothing and golf shoes
 - tailored shorts, skirts, skorts of a respectable length
 - golf socks of any colour or length (trousers not to be tucked into socks)
 - hats & caps facing forward

- **Not Allowed:**
 - vests or racer back shirts
 - blue denim jeans
 - combat shorts with multiple pockets
 - casual shorts
 - trainers

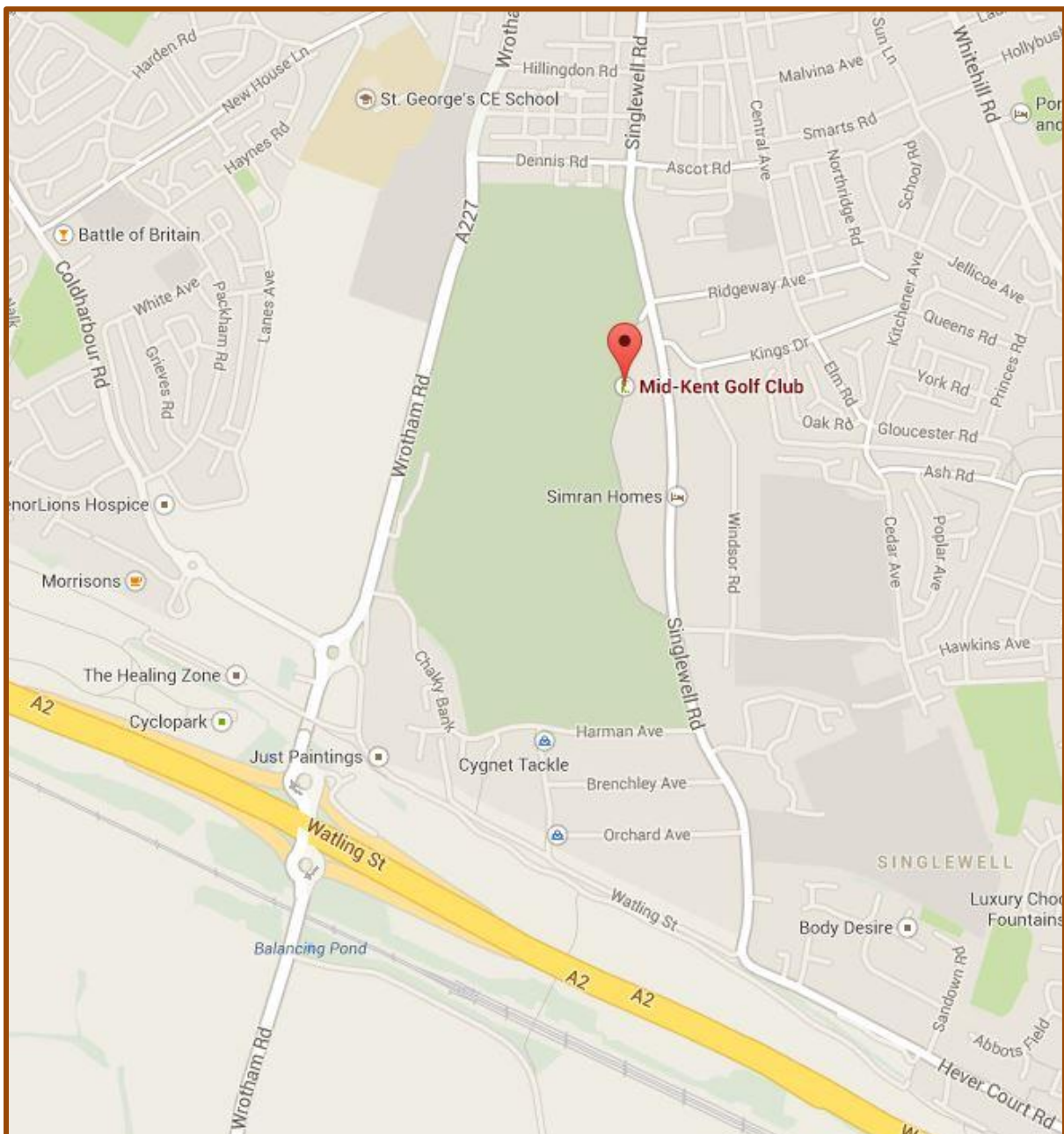
