General Data Protection Regulation

As you may know the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is being implemented in all EU countries as of the 25th May 2018.

This will impose stricter conditions for companies collecting, storing, and managing individuals' data.

The Golf Club securely holds appropriate personal information pertaining to you which is essential to the running of your Golf Club. This includes contact information, home address, date of birth etc.

We may in the running of the golf club use your personal information for any of the following reasons:

- To contact members about their membership?
- email newsletters, information, offers and marketing to members (you have the option to opt out of these communications)
- We currently share data about our members with required third parties. CONGU registration, Club V1 registration, other members when relating to golfing matters.

For us to retain your data and contact you regarding your own stored content, as well as sharing various golfing matter updates, it is necessary for you to give us permission to do so.

At any time you can request access to the information we hold about you.

Could you please email the Secretary giving the club permission to keep the information we hold or visit the office where you can sign a form which will give us permission to hold the relevant information? Failure to give us permission will result in us having to erase all information from our data store; this in turn will result in you as a member not receiving relevant information appertaining to the running of the club, your membership which also includes handicapping.
