 Side of 2nd green Hawkstone has been clipped back so use of 3rd medal tees can be available, the rhododendron will grow back pretty quick but will be easier to maintain. It was pointed out that this slope

- could be a risk hazard with golfers retrieving balls and there being numerous rabbit holes. Drop zone to be implemented.
- In between bunkers on 2nd hole Hawkstone is now rough not fairway.
- The 4th hole, the steps have been roped off, please be vigilant of golfers playing from 5th tee.

- Robin Mackness (2018 Captain) commented on how constructive the meeting was.
- Ian George wanted a green keeping revenge day for the members including obstacles, cross country golf etc. the idea was received well by all, any monies to be donated to captain's charity.
