Entries will open at 9am on Thursday 1st February, and will close on Friday 4th May 2018 after which all entrants will be notified of acceptance (or non-acceptance if the entry is oversubscribed). There will be no refunds after the closing date.

EASTERN COUNTIES CUP CONDITIONS

The competition is open to any amateur ("Competition" handicap 12 or less) who is a full member of any affiliated golf club in the counties of Suffolk, Norfolk, Cambridgeshire or Essex.

Entries will only be accepted on the above form which should be emailed to the Club Secretary of Woodbridge Golf Club. If the entry is oversubscribed, there will be a ballot on handicap.

The competition will consist of 36 holes medal play, played on handicap.

The competitor returning the best net score for the 36 holes will be presented with the Cup, which will be retained at Woodbridge Golf Club.

There will be a prize for the runner-up and a prize for the best scratch score.

Ties will be decided on the best second round, then the last nine holes (10 to 18 on the card).

There will also be prizes for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in both the morning and afternoon rounds but no competitor may win more than one prize.

Failure to comply with these conditions will render the competitor liable to disqualification at the discretion of the committee. Any dispute must be referred to the committee in writing. The decision of the committee will be final. The committee also reserves the right to refuse any entry and to make such alterations to the conditions as considered necessary.

Notes: 1.This is a qualifying competition and, in entering, all players acknowledge themselves bound to report their scores to their Home club.
