The Trustees Prize

While Saturday's weather did nobody any favours there was 74 golfers who ventured out but probably as many as 20 didn't make it to the starting line on Saturday morning and indeed many feared that the course would close but by 11 a.m. all looked good.... but it didn't stay good. Of the 74 who played Garett Condon was the overall winner with 38 points but just got there, courtesy of his back nine. Garrett started well with three successive pars but then came a mini disaster on the 4th where he failed to score and blanked again on the 9th and turned in only 17 points. Things got better on the back nine which he covered in just two over par for a further 21 points and 38 total.

Category 1 was won by Lar Whelan playing off of 5 and though he started with a blank he recovered very well to shoot 18 points on the front nine and played excellent golf on the homeward run – just 2 over par – for a further 19 points and 37 total. Lar is also very much keeping in contact with the leaders in the Player of the Year competition.

Category 2 was won by Bryan Kennedy off of 12 handicap. A relatively new member who hits a wonderful 2 iron off of the tee and it paid dividends on Saturday when he started with a birdie for 4 points. He scored on all the front nine holes and turned in an excellent 21 points. Very consistent on the back nine but had one blank and finished with 17 points for a 37 total Category 3 was won by Shane Ryan off of 20 handicap. A member who doesn't figure often in the winner's enclosure but almost made it to the top of the podium this week when he scored 38 points helped in no little way by a great birdie 2 on the 8th. Shane was the only one of the 4 winners who scored at every hole on the course.
