WELCOME TO DAVENPORT GOLF CLUB

We are proud of the facilities we offer and we want you to enjoy your time with us both on the course and in the Club House.

For the benefit and enjoyment of all our members and guests, we would ask you to comply with the following etiquette and guidelines, particularly if you are playing the course for the first time.

On the Course

Information on tees of the day, course works or anything else that affects play is displayed on the wall adjacent to the putting green. Please check before you tee off.

The **1st tee** is behind the Pro-Shop. Check that the fairway is clear before teeing off. There is a bell up on the left side of the fairway, please ring this to signal all clear to the player(s) behind. The Out Of Bounds line on the left of the fairway applies only to the adjacent **18th hole**, however please shout FORE should you hit left of the trees.

Follow the path on the left around the back of the **1st green** to the **2nd tee**

Holes 1-4 are on the clubhouse side. From the **4th green** you must go down the entrance driveway and cross the road to play **holes 5-13**

Please repair pitch marks and rake bunkers

Please replace divots on fairways and use the soil/seed mix in the boxes provided on each tee to repair divots

If using a buggy, follow the route using the instructions provided

Please **do not** take trolleys between greens and adjacent bunkers

We want you to enjoy the course but please **avoid slow play** as this causes frustration and annoyance. Be aware of those following you and call faster players/smaller groups through if possible. 4 hours should be sufficient for a 4 ball to complete their round. Only one ball should be played. (Solo players may play two balls, providing that others behind are not held up).

Please wear appropriate shoes and clothing both on the course and in the Club House. In particular observe the following dress codes and etiquette:

Caps should be worn with the peak forwards

Tailored shorts and predominantly white socks are requested

Shirts should be tucked in

Smart casual is the dress code for the Club House including smart denim

Mobile phones are for emergency use **ONLY** on the course and should be used discreetly in the Club House

Above all enjoy your day with us and please do your best to ensure that others enjoy their day too
