MEN CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP CUP

Background

Presented February 1932 by Charley Young, a local butcher, presumably to honour the 21st anniversary of the founding of the club.

Note: Mr Young had a number of shops in the Tyneside area and gave Ronnie Wood his first job. Winner received cup and 20 shillings – runner-up 10 shillings.

Format History

No evidence to confirm, but it is felt it was always a competition won by best gross over 36 holes.
1970: confirmed as 36 holes gross strokeplay.

Current

36 holes gross strokeplay. Best aggregate gross over two rounds.
First round played with a Sunday Stroke. Second round played later on the same day.
Sunday Stroke prize fund paid out as normal
Prizes paid from Competition income fund for the Club Champion and Runner-up.
Nominal entry fee for the second round, plus sweep.
Players in second round to tee off in reverse order of scores in the first round.
White tees when available.
