Pro's Tip

A tough par four with out of bounds to the right. Aim your tee shot left of centre to allow for the left to right slope. For your second remember that it is uphill to the green, so take enough club. A par here is always a good score.

Aim your tee shot at the right half of the fairway to allow for the right to left slope. The approach shot is downhill into the green.

A testing par four to finish the front nine. Longer hitters need to aim left of the marker post to avoid running out of fairway to the right. For your second shot, the approach is downhill. Better a little short than too long.

Pro's Tip

A par five to be played with the head rather than the heart. Long hitters can risk threading their drive between the OOB on the left and the humps on the right and get up in two (or if downwind, aim at the flag and take on the humps). However, the percentage play is to take from the tee a club to get you 220 yards down the fairway from where an accurate medium iron shot just right of the centre will leave you just a short iron shot to the green. It is a very tricky green surround, so make sure you hit a positive shot into the green. A par here is always a good score.

Pro's Tip

Long hitters can have a go, but the risk is not worth the reward. From the back tee, ideally a shot to the corner and then a pitch up to the green. From whichever tee you are playing, this is one hole where it is better to be short of the pin than beyond it as there is lots of trouble over the back. The green slopes from back to front and you want to leave yourself an uphill putt.

Pro's Tip

Intimidating from the tee, but there is more room around the green than it first appears. Ideally, you want to leave your tee shot just short of the pin for an easier uphill putt. Check the pin position as it is a large green.
