Local Rules 2019

1/ Out of Bounds. (Rule 18.2b)

a) Beyond all boundary hedges, fences, walls and gates (which are Integral Objects), bounding the course. The out of bounds is defined as: Hedges, the inside edge of the hedge trunk at ground level. Gates, vertically below inside edge of closed gate.

b) The greenkeepers compound to the left of the second hole marked by white posts.

c) Beyond the white posts above the practice putting green and to the right of the 18th green.

2/ Ground under repair (Rule 16.1)

All areas of the course marked GUR, encircled with white lines and/or displaying ground under repair signs. Players may take relief under Rule 16.1. Note: Relief must be taken when areas are marked as play prohibited.

3/ Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16.1)

All man-made, artificially surfaced roads and paths are Immovable Obstructions. The Greenkeepers shed between the 1st and 4th holes (and surrounding artificial surfaces) and the half-way house are Immovable Obstructions. Players may take relief under Rule 16.1

Sprinkler Heads are Immovable Obstructions. Players may also take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is: On the line of play, and is: Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball.

4/ Integral Objects.

- a) The wall to the right of the 2nd green, supporting the 3rd tee.
- b) The sleeper retaining the Crab Apple tree on the left side of the 18th hole.
- c) All roads and paths not defined in Local Rule 2.

5/ Protection of Young Trees.

Relief must be taken from protected trees or bushes where these are identified by either stakes, banding, or plastic or wire netting. (Rule 16.1)

Penalty for Breach of Local Rules 2 and 5:

The General Penalty : Match Play loss of hole, Stroke Play two strokes.

Distance Markers

Posts at 150 yards and Fairway Markers at 100, 150 and 200 yards (Par 5s only) to the centre of the green.
