#### **Conditions of Booking**

#### General

Final player and meal requirements must be confirmed at least 7 days prior to visit. All meals booked at this time must be paid for.

All Green fees and catering fees must be paid to the Professional prior to commencement of play.

### **Play**

The allocated tee times must be strictly adhered to.

Play will be from the yellow tees (gentlemen) and the red tees (ladies).

### Individual competitions may only be played in 2 & 3 balls.

Betterball competitions may be played in 4's but Texas Scrambles and similar formats are not allowed.

## **Handicaps & Etiquette**

All members of the party must be conversant with the Rules of Golf and Course Etiquette.

The course is to be treated with due respect with players replacing divots, repairing pitch marks and raking bunkers etc.

#### **Dress Rules**

Smart casual clothing may be worn at all times. A **roll-neck sweater** or a **shirt with collar and sleeves** is a required part of such dress and, unless having a ribbed

waist-band, must be tucked into trousers.

**Dining Room** Smart casual dress. It is assumed this will NOT be the clothing that was worn on the course.

**Golf Course** In addition to the above footwear must be golf shoes except that caddies or spectators may wear trainers or sports shoes.

Tailored shorts may be worn but **must** be accompanied by knee length golf socks or **calf length sports socks predominantly white in colour.**TAILORED SHORTS are allowed in the clubhouse for both men and women during the SUMMER MONTHS ONLY ( which are defined as the start and end of British Summer Time) .

# The following are not acceptable:-

Denim clothing of any kind.

Collarless or sleeveless shirts. Football or rugby shirts.

Jeans style or combat style trousers. (Jeans are defined as trousers of any material or colour with patch pockets and rivets.) Trousers tucked into socks.

Track or shell suits. Beach, football, running or cycling shorts.

Shoes without socks. Trainers or sports shoes (except caddies or spectators on the Course).

Waterproof, wet or dirty clothing in the Bar, Lounge or Dining Room.

Caps or hats in the Club House. (Baseball or similar caps worn on the Course **must** be worn with the peak at the front).

Golf equipment is an ever more attractive target for opportunist thieves and we would ask that you take every precaution to protect yours.
