General Rules for all competitions

1. It is the responsibility of all players to ensure that they are aware of, understand and abide by, all the rules of the competition.
2. Qualifying competitions and trophy rounds will normally be played from the white tees but some may be played from the yellow tees. The tee in use will be noted on the relevant competition sheet which will be displayed on notice boards at the time the competition is held.
3. All individual medal and stableford competitions shall be played in two or three ball format. Individual play in groups of four are **not** permitted. The penalty for such breach of this *Local Rule - Condition of Competition* is disqualification.
4. With the exception of non-trophy singles medal and stableford competitions, entry into all Club Competitions is restricted to members holding Active Handicaps.
5. All competitors are required to register their entry on the "PSR" terminal located in the Professional shop before commencing play. A player is **NOT** entered in the competition unless they have done so.
6. All scorecards must show clearly the name and handicap of each player. Cards should be signed and placed in the box outside the locker room.
7. In addition to submitting their properly completed scorecards, ALL competitors are required to enter their scores in the PSI system when it is in use. Failure to use the PSI system when it is in use may result in members being barred from future competitions.
8. Restricted members may enter competitions which are not specifically limited to full members (this will be noted on the specific competitions' sheet) provided that they play within their membership category's restricted times.
9. In competitions where ladies and men compete for the same prizes, ladies will play from the red tees but their scores will be calculated in accordance with the men's card. Extra strokes will be awarded to the ladies as a function of the difference between the SSS of the respective courses – 2 strokes if men play from the yellow tees and 1 stroke if men play from the white tees.
10. Where a match play competition final, a play off or a knockout match ends in a tie, extra holes will be played until the tie is decided. The extra holes shall begin at the hole where the match began. Handicap strokes shall be taken in the usual way for the extra holes. For a play off, the handicaps used will be those that applied when the original competition round was played.
11. In the winter months – from the last Sunday in October to the last Saturday in March (ie when the clocks are on Greenwich Mean Time) – all four-ball competitions will be played off both tees. ALL HANDICAP QUALIFYING ROUNDS during the winter period will be played from the YELLOW TEES. White tees are to be used only for the New Year Trophy and matches in the winter knockout competitions.
12. Rules pertaining to the Junior Section are posted on the Juniors' noticeboard.
