

## Associate Membership - Terms and Conditions (21st March 2016)

Associate Member – Definition

A playing member who pays an annual membership fee plus a green fee for each round of golf played. Play and practice restricted to Sunday to Friday each week (6 days).

Category open to **new** members only. Existing members are not eligible to transfer. Past members must have been a non-member for a minimum of 2 membership years.

**Conditions of Membership** 

Associate Members are subject to all rules and bye-laws of the Club.

The annual membership fee will be determined by Council each year and be payable in one amount at the start of each membership year, membership fee for 2016 is £75 plus £13.50 EGU membership and an initial £50 credited to the members card for the purchase of drinks, food and beverages

Green fees payable will be charged at the equivalent to guest fees prevailing at the time. Associate members may purchase blocks of green fees at a discounted rate. Green fee tag for current round being played must be displayed on golf bag throughout the round.

Associate Members may introduce guests in accordance with the bye-law relevant to "Visitors and Guests". Guests to be charged the guest fee prevailing at the time.

Associate Members are eligible to play in weekday and Sunday competitions (with the exception of two day competitions spanning Saturday and Sunday), having paid the relevant green and competition entrance fees. They are not eligible to enter Saturday competitions or any Club knockout competition.

Associate Members are permitted unlimited use of the practice facilities on any day on which a green fee has been paid and unrestricted access to the clubhouse on any day. The use of all Club facilities is subject to, and in accordance with, Club rules, bye-laws and these terms and conditions.

The number of Associate Members admitted to the category may be limited by Council at any time.
