The rain came on Friday and by Saturday afternoon the course was beginning to show a bit of green but it wasn't the only Greene on the course and the two Billys, ie., Greene and Lambe had all the intentions of burning up the course when they scored an incredible 48 points.

Incredible is the right word to describe the score because it came off of 9/10 of the handicaps and with a blank on the par four eleventh and with Billy Greene having a shot there the score could conceivably have been 52. They started with three straight pars and with brilliant dovetailing they were soon under par with a birdie four at the 4th. This was followed by four more pars and then a second birdie, this time on the par five 9th for a two under par first nine and level 3s on the scorecard. Starting back with a par on the tenth they then had their only blemish when both failed to score on the par four eleventh. They went to three over for the next five holes but a birdie par finish gave them a further 21 points for their 48 total.

There was a real contest for the runner up spot where no less than four partnerships tied on 45 points - good enough to win on any other day - but the cream of these four cards came from Michael O'Neill and Donncha Doyle who blitzed the back nine in three under par for 25 points which was the best back nine of the day.

Vale Oil Singles - Sunday 29th

Even the very poor weather on Sunday didn't prevent a good number of players entering this singles stableford competition and it didn't stop Lar Whelan from hitting 40 points off of his 6 handicap. Lar got off to a poor start, failing to score any point on the first but he settled down quickly and went on to amass 21 points for the first nine, helped by a hat trick of birdies from the 5th. He was three over par for the first five holes on the back nine by birdies on 15 and 18 saw him collect an additional 19 points for a winning total of 40. In second place was another low man, Liam Phelan playing off of 3 handicap. Liam was out in one over par for 18 points and was level par on the back nine for a further 20 points and hid 38 points total was just good enough to get through on the back nine.
