

Ladies' Midweek Random Pairs Matchplay Trophy

This is a pairs matchplay knock-out competition open to all Lady members with a current CONGU Handicap, who have played in at least four Qualifying Competitions within the 12 months prior to the 31st January in the year of the competition.

The handicap allowance will be 90% of the difference between the handicaps of the players. The lowest handicap player allocated zero strokes with the other three players playing off 90% of the difference between their handicaps and that of the lowest handicap player.

Play in all rounds shall be from the red wooden tees of the day. The exception being on the 6th hole when the red tees of the day are placed at the forward tee then play must be off the red stone blocks. Matches will generally be arranged to be played during the week. However, providing all players consent, a weekend date may be agreed.

All matches shall be played by the play-by dates shown on the Draw Sheet for the Competition, which will be posted on the Notice Board.

Both pairs are responsible for arranging and completing the match by the play-by date. Matches not played by the play-by date will generally result in both pairs being disqualified. Nevertheless, it is acceptable for a pair to concede a match to their opponents. In such circumstances the Competition Organiser must be notified. Any problems in arranging matches must be reported to the Competition Organiser before the play-by date.

In cases of dispute or to request an extension to play-by dates, applications must be made through the Competition Organiser to the Ladies' Committee for consideration prior to the relevant play-by date. Such extensions will only be granted in exceptional circumstances.

If for any reason a player withdraws before (and in a reasonable time period) the deadline date for their match to be played, a qualifying substitute may play in their stead provided none of their first round matches has been played. If for any reason a person has to withdraw, their partner can still play the match as a single versus a pair.

A Competition Entry Form must be completed and the entry fee, which will be stated on the sign-up sheet, paid to the Treasurer before the date of the draw. Completed forms together with fees may be put in an envelope, addressed to the Treasurer and posted into the 'Treasurer's Box'.

This competition cannot be played at the same time as any other competition.
