- 1 An application form must be filled out by each applicant, irrespective of the category of membership applied for.
- 2 No application form will be considered until it is fully completed.
- 3 Temporary membership will be given to all applicants on payment of the appropriate subscription. This will entitle the applicant to enjoy the benefits of a member whilst their application is being processed.
- 4 Your application form will be considered by the General Committee at their next meeting. (Meetings are held at the beginning of each month).
- 5 The categories of membership from **1<sup>st</sup> April 2017** are as follows:
  - (i) Full playing member £641 for men and ladies
  - (ii) Joint playing member (couples only) - £1270 per couple.
  - (iii) Intermediate playing member (resident in Devon or Cornwall but more than 16 miles from LGC) - £585 or £1130 Joint
  - (iv) Country playing member (resident outside Devon and Cornwall):  
Single - £403; Joint - £786.
  - (v) Full Playing member over 75 - £564.
  - (vi) Junior playing member (under 18 yrs old or in full time tertiary education) – £30 to £45 depending on age to *include* dues & insurance
  - (vii) Colt playing member (18 to 21 yrs old) £253  
Special rates for 22 to 29 year olds – apply to office.
  - (viii) Social non-playing member (inc. VAT) - £15. (Joint £28)
  - (ix) Affiliated membership is open to members of recognised golf clubs at £335 for 5-day and £388 for 7 day.
  - (x) 22-50 year old, first year only completely new member - £313
  - (xi) Flexible membership £313 payable in advance for 15 rounds of golf throughout the year.

To these fees must be added County and Union dues where applicable, Men - £18.25 Ladies - £18.75. and Golf Guard personal liability insurance £4.75 (£2 for Juniors).

**Payment of the above fees (except category xi) may be made by standing order for which the Club charge an administration fee; forms are available from the Secretary.**

Launceston Golf Club is registered as a Community Amateur Sports Club

The Club is open to all of the community including those on modest or low incomes. Any member or prospective member whose financial circumstances do not allow them to pay an annual membership subscription and associated costs of more than £520.00 is invited to apply to the Secretary and demonstrate that any sum above this figure is not affordable to them. An application will then be considered by the Management Committee and if accepted an alternative fee structure will be offered to the applicant.
