3.0 Cancellation of Open Competitions

There are a number of reasons for a cancellation of an Open Competition and action will depend on the following:

3.1 Before the competition begins it is cancelled.

- Competitions shall have a backup date. Any visitor that cannot make the second date will be given a voucher for 18 holes, which will be valid for a period of 6 months from the date when the original competition was due to be played.

3.2 Play has to be abandoned on the day of the competition the following will apply:

- If 50% of players have completed the round then the prizes will be awarded to those who have finished over the full 18 holes and the rest of the field will receive a voucher.
- If less than 50% complete their round but all of the field have completed more than 10 holes prizes will be awarded, but based on the number of holes that the last group have been able to play (10 holes or more).
- Each Visitor who has not been able to complete their round will be presented with a voucher for a complimentary round of Golf, which shall be valid for a period of 6 months from the date when the competition was played.
- HGC members will be reimbursed if no prizes are awarded.
