Edgar Lonergan was the leading qualifier and John Kidd won the Visitors Prize.

But the day wasn't all about golfers and golf scores for there was a marvellous evening in the Club - MC on the night John Bolger - where the beautiful prizes were presented by the Vice-Captain in the presence of his wife and also his parents and other family members who had travelled all the way from Co.
