Basingstoke Golf Club Terms and Conditions

Society / Company Golf Days

Societies / Companies are welcome at Basingstoke Golf Club and we can offer you a superb Course with excellent hospitality and private dining facilities. Our aim is to provide you with first class service from arrival to departure to ensure you have a memorable day.

Packages

- 18, 28* or 36 hole packages to suit your individual requirements.
(* additional 10 holes that return you to the clubhouse rather than the normal 9 holes)
- Reduced package prices for larger Societies.
- Seasonal price adjustments on all packages.
- Our normal society days are Wednesday and Thursday (but please ask if other days are available)

(Please see the society package information for specific details and prices.)

Catering

Basingstoke Golf Club is renowned for the quality of its catering and our excellent chefs will provide you with food of the highest standard throughout your visit.

Payment

Unless prior alternative arrangements have been made, **full payment is required on the day** to either the office or the Clubhouse Manager at the end of the day.

Payment may be by cash, cheque or debit/credit card. Cheques payable to "Basingstoke Golf Club Ltd".

Booking

If a date has not been provisionally agreed, then please contact Basingstoke Golf Club on telephone number 01256 465990 (opt 2) before completing the booking form.

If a provisional date has already been agreed for your Society / Company to visit, then please complete and return the booking form, together with a cheque for £100.00 (which is a non-refundable deposit) which will then be deducted from your final account.

Cancellation

If the booking is cancelled with less than 7 days notice a cancellation fee of 50% of the chosen package price x the minimum number of people will be charged. If cancellation is less than 24 hours before, the full package price x the minimum number of people will be charged.

Numbers

A minimum of 12 is required, with a maximum of 72 golfers. You are welcome to invite non-playing guests, in which case only the cost of Catering will be charged to them.

Unless previously confirmed, the club will telephone within one week of the date booked to confirm numbers. Any subsequent changes to numbers after this time **MUST** be notified to the Club. In the event of a shortfall of confirmed numbers on the day, regretfully the full cost of Catering per person will be charged. Any allergy information or special dietary requirements must be advised within 48 hours notice.

If you are a member of the following, then only the Catering costs will be charged to those individuals. (Please advise the office prior to the day)

- Current playing member of Basingstoke Golf Club
- A golf club Captain in their year of office
- Current member of the PGA, Secretaries', Greenkeepers' and Stewards' Associations
(Documented proof may be requested)

Changing Facilities

The changing facilities provide ample room for any party size and the shower facilities are excellent. Complimentary towels are available for use for all guests to Basingstoke Golf Club.

There are no lockers available so we advise that all personal belongings of value should be locked in cars (out of sight) or put in golf bags.

"Nearest The Pin" and "Longest Drive"

Basingstoke GC provides all suitable markers as required and we will put them on the appropriate holes ready for your group. (Your last players will need to bring them in!!)

Recommendations	1st Option	2nd Option (if required)
Nearest The Pin	3 rd	17 th
Longest Drive	10 th	18 th

Please ensure that these markers are returned to the golf club after your round! Unfortunately, due to markers being 'misplaced' previously, regretfully we may add further costs to your invoice if markers are lost.

Trolley/Buggy Hire

Arrangements for the hire of trolleys / buggies can be made through our Professional on telephone number 01256 465990 (opt 5). Please note that there are a limited number of buggies available and use of these may be subject to weather conditions, so please telephone in advance.

Scorecards, Scoreboard & Prize Table

1. Scorecards are available in advance, on request.
2. If you wish to bring along a score sheet, we can provide a suitable display board for the day.
3. Suitable tables can be set up in the dining area for prizes, as required.
(Please advise in advance)

Rules

1. Type of play - Play can be in 2's, 3's or exceptionally 4's. However, if you are playing a **medal** or **stableford** competition i.e. individual scoring, then this must be played in **2's or 3's only**. Please speak to us first if you wish to play a Texas Scramble format.

2. Play will be from the YELLOW tee markers and all Local Rules must be observed. Rounds are normally completed within 4 hours 15 minutes. Most golfers enjoy their day if slow play is avoided!
3. The Organiser of your golf day is responsible for players' authentic handicaps and etiquette in the Clubhouse and on the Course.

Access To The Clubhouse

Should the Clubhouse entrance doors be locked at any time during your stay, access is gained by pressing the Bar / Professional Shop buzzers located by each door. Staff will then electronically release the catch and the door will be open.

Dress Code & Mobile Phone Policy

Dress Code

- * Golf or Casual tailored shirts (tucked into) tailored trousers/shorts
- * Golf shoes to be worn only on the course or patio areas
- * Socks must be worn with golf shoes and must be predominantly white sports socks (ankle, mid or calf length)
- * Socks can be removed in the clubhouse, but shoes must be worn at all times

Mobile Phones

Mobile phones may be left switched on in the Clubhouse (on silent if possible) but you must answer only in the entrance foyer; outside the clubhouse; in the car park area. Their use is not permitted elsewhere in the Clubhouse, on the patio and surrounding gardens or particularly out on the Course (except in extreme emergency conditions).
