On Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> August there was an Aggregate 4Ball competition and despite the inclement weather there was a very good turnout of players. This is a difficult competition to win because both players need to be on top of their game at the same time and throughout the eighteen holes and indeed, the winners, Mick Mullane (President of the Club) with Nick Darmody, were certainly on top of their game shooting an impressive 41 points for both nine holes giving a winning total of 82. In last week's notes much was said about the senior members winning the big prizes and indeed that trend continued this week with Nicky contributing as many points as his lower handicapped partner and indeed it's not yet known how he was persuaded to play on past the 12<sup>th</sup> but he's glad now that he did. In second place were two low handicappers, Michael O'Neill off of 4 and Eamon Lonergan off of 8 and from their handicaps they had a very good score of 79 points comprised of a brilliant outward nine of 43.

On Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> August more than 80 players played in the Singles Stableford and Brendan McCarthy got back to winning ways when he had a great score of 42 points. Brendan was really on top of his game on the outward nine which he covered in level par with one bogey and one birdie and accumulated 23 points. A little less convincing on the back nine where he struggled a bit but nonetheless had 19 points for a winning total of 42. In second place was that big hitting former Irish international hockey player Billy Bergin who came up just one short with a great back nine of 23 points to add to his outward 18.
