### **Men's Results**

#### **John O'Dwyer - The Golf Store - Singles Stableford**

There was a big turnout of players for the singles stableford competition over Saturday and Sunday which was sponsored by John O'Dwyer of the Golf Store. In excellent conditions there was very good scoring on both days and Richard Brannigan, off of 18 handicap, score 42 points on Saturday and was the overall winner. If memory serves us well this is Richard's first time in the winner's enclosure for a singles competition although he has come close before. He had two halves of 21 and did not score on the second hole but went on from there and played a very steady and consistent game over the remaining holes.

Category 1, for players from + handicap to 9 was won by Rowan O'Neill playing off of 7 handicap. Rowan was the epitome of consistency throughout the 18 holes where he scored on every hole and produced halves of 19 and 20 points respectively for his 39 points total

Category 2, for players from 10 to 17 handicaps was won by Tom O'Donnell off of 17 handicap. Tom failed to register any points at one hole, the 18<sup>th</sup> which is not easy even in the present conditions but still managed to amass a total of 42 points. Tom appears to have a love / hate relationship with a handicap of 17 because he tells us that every time he gets to 17 he immediately breaks it with a score and he'll play a lot of golf now to get back to 17 after Sunday's performance.

Category 3, for players over 18 handicap, was won by young Ian Condon, playing off of 21, Ian had a very good round of golf with halves of 17 and 19 points which was just good enough to win it on the breakdown of scores. This young man is keeping the tradition of good golfers going in the Condon household and we expect to see a lot more of him in the future.
