

SOUTHPORT OLD LINKS GOLF CLUB GENTLEMEN'S CODE OF DRESS



On the Course

Golf footwear, fitted with either hard or soft spikes or rubber pimple soles, <u>must</u> be worn. Trainers are not allowed! An appropriate Shirt with a collar attached or Polo / Turtle / Mock / Crew / Roll-Neck golf shirt or sweater, all of which must be worn inside trousers.

Tailored moderate length* shorts may be worn, provided they are worn with knee-length socks or sports socks.

Trousers <u>must</u> not be tucked into socks unless covered by waterproof trousers.

Caps <u>must</u> be worn with the peak at the front.

In the Main Lounge and Non-smoking Lounge

Smart casual dress (incl. approved golf attire) is required at all times except when an official function is taking place. Shirts must be worn inside trousers!

For official functions Jackets and Ties must be worn unless otherwise stated.

Tailored moderate length* Shorts are acceptable, provided they are worn with knee-length socks or sports socks, but only in Summer time and up to 7.30pm.

All Coats must be hung up. Caps and Hats must be removed.

Games and Trophy Room/Bunker Bar

Smart casual dress (incl. approved golf attire) is required at all times unless Council determine otherwise. Smart Jeans worn with Shoes and appropriate tops are allowed at all times. Tailored designed Shirts may be worn outside trousers in this room only. Golf Shirts, etc. must be tucked into trousers!

Tailored moderate length* Shorts are acceptable, provided they are worn with knee-length socks or sports socks, but only in Summer time.

All coats must be hung up. Caps and Hats must be removed.

Pimpled Shoes are allowed during the Summer period.

*Moderate length means that they must extend no lower than just below the knee. Calf length shorts are not acceptable.

NOT PERMITTED IN THE MAIN CLUBHOUSE ROOM OR ON THE COURSE AT ANY TIME

Denim or Leather Jeans / Trousers / Shorts, Leather Jackets (other than tailored sports jacket style with buttoned fronts), T-Shirts, sleeveless Vests, Tracksuits or parts thereof and Trainers or Trainer type footwear. N.B. If Trainers are worn by non-golfers in Fun Comps, they must change into acceptable footwear before entering the clubhouse.

Cut off Shorts, Athletic Shorts, Running Shorts and Combat style Trousers, Shorts or Jackets (e.g. Bomber style). Logos on clothing must be discreet!

MEMBERS MUST ENSURE THEIR GUESTS OBSERVE THE DRESS CODE

N.B.

The Captain, or in his absence the Vice-Captain, or in his absence the House Chairman, or in his absence a member of Council may give permission for jackets to be removed at official functions.

SOUTHPORT OLD LINKS GOLF CLUB LADIES DRESS CODE

On the Course

Golf footwear, fitted with either hard or soft spikes or rubber pimple soles, must be worn. Trainers are not allowed!

An appropriate shirt with a collar attached or a polo/turtle/mock/crew/roll-neck golf shirt or sweater must be worn.

Round-necked golf shirts with sleeves and sleeveless shirts with collars may also be worn. Shirts and golf tops may not be worn outside trousers or skirts unless they are specifically so designed.

Caps must be worn with the peak at the front.

Skirts, trousers, golf shorts and Capri trousers are all acceptable.

Trousers must not be tucked into socks unless covered by waterproof trousers.

In the Main Lounge

- Smart casual dress (incl. approved golf attire) is required at all times except when an official function is taking place
- Shirts and tops may be worn outside trousers or skirts only if so designed.
- Golf shorts are acceptable, but only in Summer time and up to 7.30pm.

For official functions the following dress is considered acceptable:-

- Smart dresses, skirts, trousers and appropriate smart tops which may be worn inside or outside as appropriate.
- Jackets and coats should not be left on the backs of chairs. Use the Cloakroom!

Games and Trophy Room/Bunker Bar

- Smart casual dress (incl. approved golf attire) is required at all times unless Council determine otherwise.
- Shirts and tops may be worn outside trousers or skirts only if so designed.
 Golf shorts are acceptable, but only in Summer time.
- Jackets and coats should not be left on the backs of chairs. Use the cloakroom!

Not permitted in the Clubhouse or on the Course at any time (unless Council determine a function dictates a certain type of clothing)

- T-shirts
- · Round-necked shirts without sleeves
- Cropped tops
- Jeans
- Cargo Trousers
- Short shorts
- Leggings
- Tight Lycra trousers
- Ski trousers
- Stirrup trousers
- · Pedal pushers
- Denim wear
- Trainers or trainer type footwear
- Leather wear other than tailored button front jackets
- Logos on clothing must be discreet!

N.B. If trainers are worn by non-golfers in Fun Comps, they must change into acceptable footwear before entering the clubhouse.
