

The third, and final, Senior's Open for 2018 took place with 174 players representing 26 clubs from Devon, Cornwall, Dorset and Somerset competing in a 3BBB competition.

Weather conditions were benign at the start and remained so for most of the day, but rain showers became more frequent later in the afternoon. However, the scores returned did not seem to reflect the changing conditions as winning teams were represented from early, mid and late starters.

Visiting golfers were very complementary of the course and administration of the day including the considerable help given by members of the host golf club in duties that included registration, starting supervision and ball spotting.

The usual raffle and Halfway House refreshments were available and the proceeds, which were all in aid of the Captain's Charity, Devon Link-Up, amounted to approx. £570.

The overall winners, with 47 points, were a Honiton team and leading scores from the host club were 45 points (1st), 45, on countback (2nd), 44 (3rd) and 42 (4th)

The visiting teams' results were very close - 45 points (1st), 45, on countback (2nd), 44 (3rd) and 43 (4th).

There were also prizes for nearest the pin and longest drive which, from the visiting players, were won by members from Folke and Teignmouth Golf Clubs.

A most enjoyable day and we hope that many of this year's players return to compete again next year.
