

SAFETY AND ETIQUETTE RULES FOR GOLFERS

This is an important document and it forms part of the Greenkeeping staff's Health and Safety procedures.

Golf at Aboyne should be an enjoyable experience. Our Greens staff will always strive to offer the very best possible conditions for golf. Greens staff where possible will not hinder or interfere with play. You however, should be aware and give consideration to them as they maintain the course on a daily basis.

Greenkeeping staff will;

- 1. Not cut greens after your approach shots during opening times.
- 2. Not follow your order of play (unless necessary).
- 3. Not cause any unnecessary nuisance.
- 4. Move out of the way when task is finished.
- 5. Bring GUR into play as soon as possible.
- 6. Produce the best possible golfing conditions.

Golfers must (Safety);

- 1. Not play onto greens in the process of being cut.
- 2. Not play from tees in the process of being cut.
- 3. Not hit a ball in the direction of or over a Greenkeeper.
- 4. Wait for Greenkeepers to move to a safe area or distance.
- 5. Shout "Fore" when hitting a stray ball.

Golfers must (Etiquette);

- 1. Replace all divots.
- 2. Repair all pitch marks.
- 3. Only practice in the designated areas.
- 4. Use trolleys and buggies in a sensible manner and observe restrictions.
- 5. Observe any signage on the course
- 6. Only play one ball (unless following the rules of golf)
