



Evening tee times for Seniors' competitions

Following requests from senior aged players who are working and, consequently, unable to play in the Seniors' counting competitions on Tuesday mornings, tee times have been reserved on the 8th and 15th May to enable evening play on those days. If the arrangement proves popular it will be extended to the remainder of the season.

Because the first tee is reserved for the Juniors until 17.30 on Tuesdays the evening play will begin at 17.15 on the 10th tee. The 1st tee is reserved at 19.15 and 19.22 for the Seniors' competitions on those days to ensure that the tee is available around the time that holes 10 to 18 are completed.

In order to indicate your intention to play you should book the tee times at 19.15 or 19.22 on the Club on-line booking system. Fraser Dunlop will act as starter for the competitions so you must check in with him at around 17.00 and pay the entry fee of £2. After entering the competition on the terminal in the clubhouse entrance players should then proceed to the 10th tee as advised by Fraser.

Completed score cards should be deposited in the box in the clubhouse entrance where they will be collected by the Seniors' section representative who will close the competition on the same evening to ensure that handicap adjustments are made prior to the following day. The normal requirements of signing in for the competitions prior to play and completion of score cards shall be followed to avoid disqualification.
