## LADIES BAXTER TROPHY

### Background

### Format History

Presented by Mrs Eleanor Baxter in 1937, wife of Colonel Baxter, President of the Club. In 1987 on the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary Mrs Baxter (then aged 92 years) presented the trophy to the winner.

### Current

Singles match play knockout. Red Tees. Full handicap. Random draw to take place the first Thursday in May. Matches to be arranged at the players' mutual convenience but on or before the date shown on the tournament chart displayed on the notice board. The first named in each pair is required to give 3 dates for the match within the specified period of time. If agreement cannot be reached the match will be NULL and VOID. In the event of a postponement in any round a definite date must be fixed at the time of postponement. Semi-final to be played by the middle of August. The final to be played by the end of August. Semi-final and final rounds may be moved only for sickness or holiday arrangements. The final MUST be played within 2 weeks of the semi-final. The Ladies Captain to act as referee for the final.

### Restrictions

No Lady (including Junior Ladies) can win a competition unless their handicap is 36 or less
