The wheels appeared to come off when he bogeyed the 13th and then double bogeyed the short par three 14th and more bogeys were to follow on 15 and 16 but he parred the par three 17th and finished with a six on the 18th for an inward nine of 18 points and his 40 points total. Thomas Murphy (17), Kevin O'Donnell. (17) and Alex Casey (11) were chasing the winner all the way but all three ended two short and shared 2nd, 3rd and 4th prizes. In 5th place was that young man Killian Butler (10) and the final prize went to Shane Ryan (18)
