DRESS CODE for Gentlemen and Ladies ON THE COURSE

ACCEPTABLE

Shirts

Tailored with collars and sleeves (including turtle neck and polo) to be worn tucked into trousers/shorts apart from those designed to be worn outside.

Trousers

Tailored with waistband (must not visibly be tucked into socks).

Shorts/Skirts

Tailored with waistband and approximately knee length

Socks

Must be worn at all times

Shoes

Must be designed specifically for golf.

<u>Headgear</u>

Must be worn with peaks/visors to the front



NOT ACCEPTABLE

Shirts

T shirts, football/rugby shirts, shirts with slogans/numbers etc.

Trousers

Denim jeans, tracksuit bottoms, combat trousers, cargo pants with patch pockets

Shorts

Beach/Bermuda shorts, rugby/football shorts, cutoffs, cargo shorts with patch pockets

Shoes

Flip flops

Headgear

Headgear must be removed before entering the clubhouse

Telephones

Must only be used in an emergency.

LADIES (EXCEPTIONS/DISPENSATIONS)

Cropped trousers and skirts are acceptable

Ladies may wear sleeveless tops.

- All users are expected to wear an acceptable and respectable form of smart/casual dress in all areas of the clubhouse.
- Golf shoes may be worn in the clubhouse but only in designated areas (Spike Bar and main corridor).
- ❖ Mobile phones must be kept on silent and voice calls can only be used in the car park, changing room or main corridor.
- Wet or soiled clothing must not be worn in the clubhouse (other than the changing room).
- Footwear must be worn at all times.

PRIVATE PARTIES/EVENING FUNCTIONS/WEDDINGS ETC.

The Dress Code will not be applicable for these functions except when specified.
